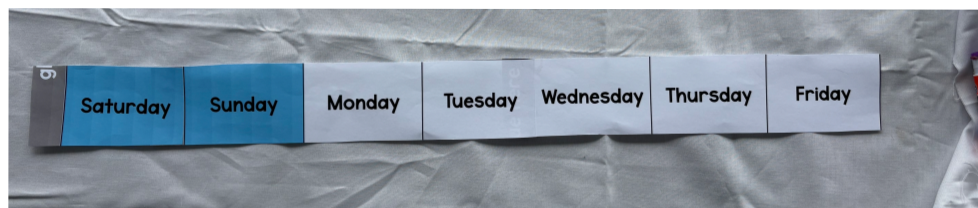
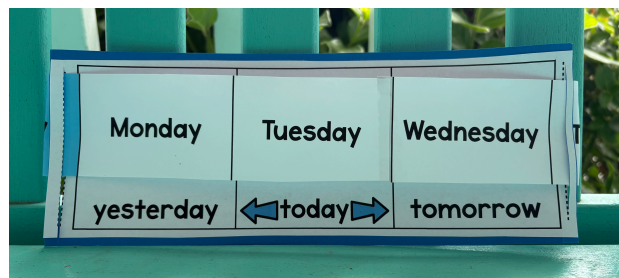
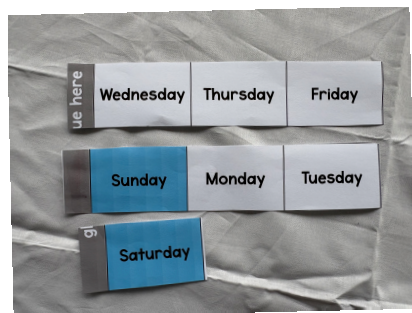
Print the templates and cut them out along the black dotted lines. Do NOT cut along the grey dotted line yet. I glued the yesterday/today/tomorrow page on cardstock for durability.

Then glue the days of the week in order in a straight line.

yesterday	←today→	tomorrow
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Cut along the grey dotted lines, stopping at each circle. These are slits for the days of the week strip.

Thread the days of the week strip through the grey slits and glue the strips together behind the yesterday/today/tomorrow page. Do not attach it to the yesterday/today/tomorrow page.



That's it! Hang on your fridge and keep track of yesterday/today/tomorrow together!

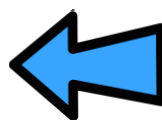
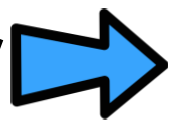

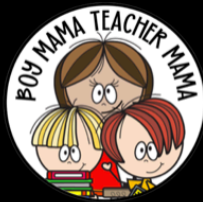
