Directions for the Ordinal Number Race

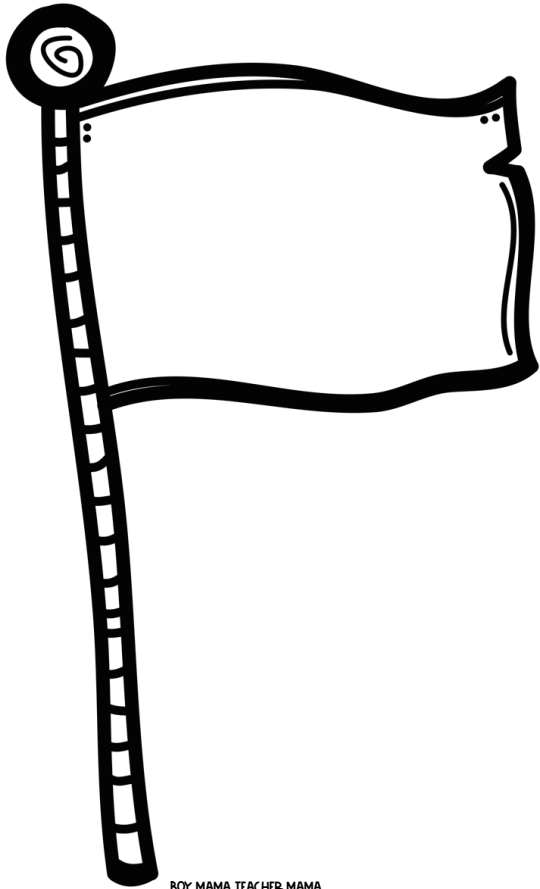
1. Photograph each child as if they are participating in a running race. Ensure all students are facing the same direction, preferably to the left. Crop each picture to approximately 3x3 inches.
2. Compile all the photos to fit on one sheet of paper. Print a set for each student in the class.
3. Print the race page and enlarge it to your preferred size.
4. Have students cut out all the pictures of their classmates. I recommend having them collect their photos in a plastic bag to keep them organized and prevent loss. Have them put the two race pages together by gluing on the grey line.
5. Instruct students to color the two flags on the race page. The first flag should be green for Start/Go, and the second flag should be red for Stop/Finish.
6. Have students turn all the pictures face down on the tabletop.
7. Instruct them to select one picture at a time and place the pictures on the race board in the order they pick them. They should glue the pictures in place.
8. Have students write 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc., above the head of each racer on the paper, ensuring they start with 1st above the person who finishes the race first.
9. Finally, have students fill out the recording sheet with the placement and name of each finisher.
